Location and travel

A reminder of where we are:

The University of Chichester has 2 campuses in West Sussex, on the south coast of England. One is in Chichester, one in Bognor Regis. Key selling points of Chichester: a safe, historic cathedral town (pop. 30,000) near the sea and the South Downs National Park. Bognor Regis: a seaside town, popular with tourists. Portsmouth is around 16 miles west of Chichester; Brighton is just over 30 miles east; London is around 70 miles north (1h 45m by train to London Victoria).

A £2,500 scholarship rewarding exceptional artistic talent open to undergraduate and postgraduate students in the University of Chichester Conservatoire. Selections are made on the basis of performance at audition

Claiming commission

Commission can be claimed under the terms of your agency agreement at any time but is usually claimed in October/November, following the September intake for most programmes.

Please send a spreadsheet showing

- the names of the students you have enrolled
- their applicant ID numbers
- the courses they are enrolled on
- the annual course fee for each course
- the amount you are claiming as commission for each student
- the total you are claiming in commission

English language requirements

The University of Chichester accepts IELTS, TOEFL iBT, PTE Academic and Skills for English UKVI, among other tests, as proof of English language proficiency.

For the majority of undergraduate courses, IELTS 6.0 overall (with no less than 5.5 in any paper) is the standard requirement. For most postgraduate courses, IELTS 6.5 (with no less than 5.5 in any paper) is the standard requirement.

Medium of Instruction letters cannot normally be accepted on their own as proof of English language proficiency.

Some country- or region-specific examinations in English language (the Indian Standard XII, for instance, or the WAEC) are accepted.

Pre-sessional courses

For students who have not met its English language proficiency requirements, the University of Chichester offers 10- and 5-week pre-sessional programmes.

Costs, entry requirements and start dates are as follows for 2025 entry:

10 weeks (June-August)	£2,625
5 weeks (July-August)	£1,470

Accommodation

Students have a choice of on- or off-campus accommodation, catered or self-catered, in Chichester or in Bognor Regis. A free shuttle bus service connects the two campuses and stops at Fishbourne and Stockbridge halls in Chichester. Accommodation contracts can be of 39-, 41-, 50- or 51-weeks' duration. Fees range from £148.33/week to £295.19/week
